



RURAL RESPITE PROGRAM

FOR THOSE LIVING WITH MEMORY LOSS

CAREGIVERS RECEIVE:

- 3.5 hours of respite time
- Monthly meeting with a Care Navigator

CARE RECIPIENTS RECEIVE:

- 3.5 hours of activities in a group setting
- Person centered program by dementia-certified staff

This program is available to individuals who:

- Are living with memory loss
- Are able to benefit from a group setting
- Do not need assistance with activities of daily living
- Reside in Adams, DeKalb, Huntington, LaGrange, Noble, Steuben, Wells or Whitley County
- Are able to provide their own transportation
